

Phrasal Verbs Related to RIDING & DRIVING

1. Drive Off:



- Meaning: To leave in a vehicle.
- Example: He waved goodbye and drove off down the road.

2. Drive By



- Meaning: To pass a place or person in a vehicle.
- Example: We drove by the park to see if it was open.



3. Drive Away



- Meaning: To leave a place in a vehicle.
- Example: They quickly drove away after the event ended.

4. Drive Up



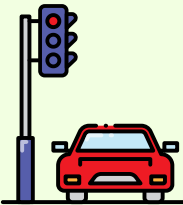
- Meaning: To arrive at a place in a vehicle.
- Example: She drove up to the store and parked right outside.

5. Drive Back



- Meaning: To return to a place by driving.
- Example: After our trip, we drove back to the city.

6. Pull Over



- Meaning: To stop at the side of the road.
- Example: The officer signaled for the driver to pull over.

7. Pull Out



- Meaning: To start driving onto the road.
- Example: He pulled out of the driveway slowly.

8. Pull Up



- Meaning: To stop a vehicle, usually in front of a place.
- Example: The taxi pulled up in front of her house.

9. Hop On



- Meaning: To quickly get on a bike, motorbike, or other vehicle.
- Example: She hopped on her bike and rode to the park.

10. Hop Off



- Meaning: To get off a bike, motorbike, or vehicle quickly.
- Example: He hopped off his scooter when he reached the store.



Phrasal Verbs Related to RIDING & DRIVING

11. Get In



- Meaning: To enter a car or taxi.
- Example: She got in the car and buckled her seatbelt.

12. Get Out



- Meaning: To exit a car or taxi.
- Example: They got out of the car at the beach.

13. Get On



- Meaning: To board a bus, train, or bike.
- Example: We got on the bus just before it left.



14. Get Off



- Meaning: To leave a bus, train, or bike.
- Example: She got off the train at her stop.



15. Speed Up



- Meaning: To increase speed.
- Example: The driver sped up to overtake the truck.

16. Slow Down



- Meaning: To reduce speed.
- Example: He slowed down as he approached the stop sign.

17. Run Over



- Meaning: To hit someone or something with a vehicle.
- Example: Be careful not to run over the cones in the road.

18. Ride Along



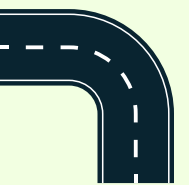
- Meaning: To go along with someone in their vehicle.
- Example: I decided to ride along with my friend to the concert.

19. Back Up



- Meaning: To move a vehicle in reverse.
- Example: He backed up the car to get out of the parking spot.

20. Turn Off



- Meaning: To leave the main road and go onto a smaller one.
- Example: Turn off here if you want to go to the lake.
